PURPOSE

The ideal candidate will have a deep understanding of ongoing USAID programs in Egypt, as well as expertise in the Egyptian education system, STEM education, and related fields.

DESCRIPTION OF NEEDS AND SERVICES

- Produce a report detailing:
 - targeted information on USAID Egypt and Ministry of Education and Technical Education (MOETE)
 priorities related to STEM education
 - o targeted information on the competitive environment
 - o list of key contacts within MOETE and working with MOETE related to STEM education
- Identify and document Egyptian institutions that currently support the integration of STEM into Egyptian public schools, including an overview of the organization, capabilities, and key contacts.
- Overview of the current status of STEM integration into Egyptian public schools, including school locations, grades in which STEM is introduced, and linkages the schools may have with the private sector or higher education institutions.

Qualifications
